

SUPPLEMENTAL EDUCATIONAL SERVICES PROVIDERS FREE TUTORING SERVICES

Supplemental Educational Services (SES) include summer and before- and after-school tutoring in reading, language arts, or math. They may be offered through public- or private-sector providers who are approved by the state, such as public schools, public charter schools, local education agencies (local school systems, herein referred to as LEAs), educational services agencies, faith-based organizations, and community groups.

Students from low-income families who remain in Title I schools that fail to meet AYP for at least three years, and are thus in the second year of Needs Improvement status, are eligible to receive SES.

The SES Provider's code, name, and Providers who serve special needs and ELL students are listed. Only 12 SES providers indicated by two asterisks (**) have report cards for your review.
