

Supplemental Educational Services

In Elbert County School System

According to the No Child Left Behind statute, parents may request information about the professional qualifications of their child's teacher(s). A parent may request any of the following:

- certification status of the teacher(s)
- college and/or graduate degree(s) held by the teacher(s)
- qualifications of any paraprofessional providing services to your child

The No Child Left Behind Act of 2001 (NCLB) states that parents of children enrolled in schools that receive Title I funding and that are identified by the state as "Needs Improvement" must have the opportunity to transfer their children to a school that has not been so identified and/or enroll their child in supplemental educational services (i.e., free tutoring). Parents of students eligible for School Choice or Supplemental Educational Services are notified by the district. During the past three years, Elbert County Schools has had seven schools receiving federal funds under the Title I program. However, this school year, all eight schools have been identified as Title I schools and are eligible to receive federal funds which includes the Elberton Education Center (alternative school). During the past four years one school has been identified as Needs Improvement and therefore the following information indicates the number of students eligible for or participating in School Choice or Supplemental Educational Services.
