Lost, Stolen or Damaged Netbooks

Netbooks that are lost, stolen or damaged beyond repair will result in a fine of \$200 and you will be placed on the owed fees list.

Netbooks unaccounted for after May 20th will be considered stolen, will result in placement on the owed fees list for \$200 and may also result in a report to the appropriate authorities.



Netbook Collection Begins May 12th

In order for you to be able to access all the resources available on your netbook for final exams, you will be allowed to retain your netbook until your last scheduled exam block. **Your netbook must be turned in after your last final exam.** (Those students that do not need their netbooks for exams may turn them in early.)

Please remember that your netbook will be re-imaged over the summer with new academic content and that **any information left on the netbook will be deleted.** Therefore it is imperative that you save your information. You can save it to a jumpdrive, the P drive, etc... However, you do not need to save any information that is already

located on eLearn.

Only academic content will be allowed to be stored on the P drive. **Routine searches will be done on this server for music and other personal files and these will be deleted.** The school will not be responsible for lost personal content.

Exempting Finals Additional Step Required for Spring Semester

Seniors may exempt final exams spring semester if they meet the following criteria:

- 85 or above average,
- No owed fees
- Netbook is returned*
- No more than 3 unexcused absences/3 days OSS in class student is trying to exempt

*** Seniors will not receive a diploma if netbook has not been turned in.**

Underclassmen may exempt final exams spring semester if they meet the following criteria:

- 90 or above average
- No owed fees

- Netbook is returned
- No more than 3 unexcused absences/3 days OSS in class student is trying to exempt

Students cannot exempt the EOCT, other exemptions must be approved by the Principal
