

Elbert County Schools—Board Brief

Summary of the July 18 and July 25 Meetings

Highlights of Presentation and Discussion Items

The following items were presented to the Board:

- **Finance Report** — The Board learned that the General Fund Revenues as of June 30, 2016 for the month were \$4,015,394 and to date were \$25,838,409. The General Fund Expenditures for the month of June were \$4,942,318 and to date were \$24,626,660. The Cash Balance as of June 30, 2016 was \$4,524,47. The projected fund balance as of June 30, 2016 is \$3,853,270. SPLOST receipts for June were \$147,509. The District saved \$2,800 in energy costs due to being closed on Fridays during the summer.
- **Policy GAMB-Possession of Weapons by School Employees**-Superintendent Bell presented the Board with policy GAMB which the Board would need to approve if they want non law enforcement employees to have the capacity to carry weapons. After much discussion and legal advise Superintendent Bell recommended laying Policy GAMB-Possession of Weapons by Employees, on the table for thirty days for public review.

Highlights of Action Items

The following items were approved:

- **Personnel** -The Board approved six personnel resignations, and fourteen personnel recommendations.
- **Discipline Hearing Training**-The Board approved Northeast Georgia RESA as the training provider for discipline hearing training as required by SB 367-D.C.G.A.§20-2-759.
