ECPS School Improvement Goals 2021-2022

Goal 1: 80% of all kindergarten students will score at or above grade level on the composite total of Acadience. 80% of all first grade students will score at or above grade level on Oral Reading Fluency as measured by Acadience.

Goal 2: 70% of all kindergarten and first grade students will score at or above benchmark on spring administration of Math MAP.

Goal 3: Reduce the number of students who are chronically absent (18 or more school days the previous year) from 13% to 10% of our total school population.

Parents and staff at ECPS developed this School-Parent Compact for Achievement through our Parent Advisory Committee. Parents added specific needs and suggested strategies for learning at home. Meetings are held each year to review the compact and make changes based on students' needs.
